COVID-19 NHS Optometry Service Provision in Gwent

Currently many optometry services in Wales has been suspended, which means:

- Only urgent/essential eye care services are able to be provided to patients, which means that only essential sight tests, spectacle provision and repairs can be carried out along with treatment for acute eye care problems, providing follow up appointments where necessary and local service provision to remove foreign bodies from the eyes.
- The majority of NHS optometry practices have closed, however the following practices remain open for contact
